March 2023 Mass Layoffs Omnibus Survey
Final Topline**

This study was conducted by SSRS on its Opinion Panel Omnibus platform. The SSRS Opinion Panel Omnibus is a national, twice-per-month, probability-based survey. Data collection was conducted from March 3- March 7, 2023, among a sample of 1,027 respondents. The survey was conducted via web (n=997) and telephone (n=30) and administered in English (n=1002) and Spanish (n=25). The margin of error for total respondents is +/- 3.6 percentage points at the 95% confidence level. All SSRS Opinion Panel Omnibus data are weighted to represent the target population of U.S. adults ages 18 or older. More information about SSRS can be obtained by visiting www.ssrs.com
